Reading

- Every child is read with once a half term, either by the class teacher or teaching assistant.
- Reading lessons are 2x weekly. Children will work on their comprehension skills to answer a range of questions about a text.
- *Book change - Reading scheme book change will be on a **Monday** and **Friday**. Books will only be changed if it has been read at home (please sign the reading diary) and the child can recall the story.*
- *Library books will be changed every **Monday**. You can also sign the reading diary if these have been read at home.*

Maths

- Taught daily - mental starters, main objective and challenges.
- Arithmetic, new skills into reasoning and bookwork to end.
- Pacy/whiteboards/hard, harder and hardest.
- Strands re-visited 3 times.
- Homework will be consolidation of the learning.

Writing and SPaG

- Writing and SPaG lessons take place 3x weekly.
- SPaG: Short pacy lessons, using whiteboards and then consolidating with 3 or 4 test questions.
- Writing: Children will focus on a text for two weeks, leading up to a piece of writing we call a 'Big Write'. This is an independent piece of writing based on the text and genre focus.
- We use 'Big Writes' to assess the children in writing.

- Arithmetic style questions - 4 operations.
