



## **Welcome to Pineham Barns Primary School!**

We are delighted that your child will be joining us in September and over the coming weeks, I will be writing to you with further information detailing the transition arrangements for your child.

Since our offer day, many families have been enquiring about our wrap around care provision. As a school, we are committed to offering Breakfast & After School care from September. Breakfast Club will begin at 8am and After School Club will run until 6pm.

Families will be able to drop their children to Breakfast Club, which will provide children with a healthy breakfast ready for a busy day at school. At After School Club, the children will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities and utilise the outdoors in the finer weather. During, each After School Club session, the children will be provided with a healthy snack and water or squash will be readily available throughout.

The club will be led by fully qualified staff and will be based in the school building every day during term time. Breakfast Club will cost £3.50 per session and After School Club £8.50 per session. We accept childcare vouchers from most companies and payment will need to be made prior to the first session.

As a new school, we are committed to providing this provision for our families, but would request that parents **complete the attached form detailing their requirements and return it to [claire.clayson@pineham.org](mailto:claire.clayson@pineham.org). no later than Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May. We would also request that if you are not intending to use this facility, please could you also inform Mrs Claire Clayson at the email address above by Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May.**

Whilst in September, the school won't be full, we hope to be able to provide this provision from the very first day. However, we need to ensure that we have enough interest from families to run the provision from September 2017, so that we can plan our staffing accordingly.
