

SECTION 10 CONSULTATION REPORT SURVEY RESULTS

In total, we received 77 responses to our consultation survey from online and postal respondents. This report details the outcomes from the consultation survey.

Respondents were shown from across the admissions catchment areas of the school and also from other areas of Northampton.





Figure 1: Map of the location of respondents' postcodes

Following are the outcomes from the four key survey questions about the school that were made online or through the postal survey:


Question 1: Overall, are you in favour of Pineham Barns Primary School?



Yes	76	98.70%
No	1	1.30%
Don't Know	0	0.00%

Responses were overwhelmingly positive with 76 out of 77 respondents in favour of Pineham Barns Primary School. Only one respondent did not find in favour of the school, but the same respondent did, in fact, find in favour of the curriculum and ethos, and did believe that Pineham Barns Primary School should enter into a funding agreement with the Department for Education.


Question 2: Are you in favour of the school’s curriculum and ethos as described on this leaflet and on our website?

No	0	0.00%
Don't Know	3	4.05%

Three respondents skipped pass this question on the online survey. Again, there was an overwhelmingly positive response to the school’s curriculum and vision, and of those who did not respond with a yes, none responded against the curriculum. Although 3 respondents did not know whether they were in favour, there were no comments requesting further clarification of the curriculum and ethos.

Question 3: Will you apply for one or more places for your children at this school for September 2017?




Yes	38	49.35%

There were no negative comments made about the school from the 39 respondents who voted 'No' or 'Don't Know'. It can be presumed that as there were 37 respondents who didn't identify themselves as parents of pupils who would start the school in September, but who did find in favour of the school and the curriculum, many of these 39 either did not have children to register, or children who were not eligible for September for Reception or Y1/2.

At the close of application on 15th January 2017, the school had received 37 applications for the 30 places available in Reception.

Question 4: Do you believe Pineham Barns Primary School should enter into a funding agreement with the Department for Education?



Yes	73	94.81%

Don't Know	4	5.19%

The question as to whether Pineham Barns Primary School should enter into a funding agreement with the DfE was hugely supported by respondents.

2 of the respondents who replied 'Don't Know' left a further comment about the funding agreement, as shown below:

"I currently don't know enough about the funding agreement to comment on it"

"I am not entirely aware if the funding mentioned will actually benefit the children and/or the standard of teaching delivery!"

The funding will be equivalent to the funding of maintained schools and academies and will be dependent on the number of pupils attending. It will

ensure that the school is able to staff and resource appropriately for the number of pupils on roll, and ensure the appropriate functioning of the school and its curriculum.

Conclusion

On the basis of the responses to the consultation, the Trust board are agreed that they wish to enter into a Funding Agreement with the Secretary of State to open the school from September 2017.

The board of Preston Hedge's Academy Trust are hugely appreciative of the support that we have received from the local community of Pineham and Hunsbury Meadows. We commit to continuing to work with all stakeholders to ensure that Pineham Barns Primary School reflects the needs and aspirations of the community, and look forward to delivering an outstanding start for the communities of Pineham and Hunsbury Meadows.
