## Online Safety

A huge thank you to Mrs Dell for organising our Online Safety Workshop with Simon Aston from Northamptonshire County Council. Thank you to all the parents who joined us, I know many of you found it very useful and insightful to ensure that your children are safe online. For those of you who weren't able to make the workshop, here are some of the key facts from the session.

- The average age of an online gamer is 34
- 74% of gaming is made up by adults
- 74% of free mobile apps sell on our personal information, this includes social media and Tik Tock
- 1 in 3 child sexual offences now starts online in Northamptonshire
- 90% of 12 16 year olds in the UK believe their parents don't follow their own rules on screen time
