Important Dates

Year 1 Phonics Screening – Week commencing 6th June for 1 week

Year 2 SATs – Week commencing 2nd May until the end of May

Year 4 Multiplication Check – Week commencing 6th June for 3 weeks

Year 6 SATs – Week commencing 9th May for 1 week
