Reading

- Every child is read with every week either by the class teacher or teaching assistant.
- Book change for all Year 1 children book change will be on a **Tuesday** and **Friday**.
 Books will only be changed if it has been read at home and the child can recall the story.
- In Year 1, children are encouraged to re-read stories so that they can: answer and ask questions, retell the story and participate in discussions about the book.
- In Year 1, children can choose a book from the library to take home and these will be changed every Friday.



Phonics

- In Year 1, we follow the same Phonics scheme as Reception (ELS).
- We teach Phonics twice daily.
- Children are assessed regularly and interventions take place daily to support children where needed.
- Children are encouraged to use their knowledge of Phonics to support their spelling and reading.



Maths

- Taught daily mental starters, main objective and challenges.
- In Year 1, we use lots of resources to support their understanding and make it as practical as possible.
- Pacey/ whiteboards/ hard, harder and hardest.
- We focus on 4 key areas in Maths: arithmetic and number, shape, measure and data handling. Each topic is revisited more than once throughout the year.





Handwriting

Pre- cursive handwriting.

 At least 3 sessions a week (practical activities e.g. writing in the air, practising on whiteboards)

Rewards


- Reader of the Week and Handwriter of the Week certificates can be awarded in Friday assemblies.

- Secret smiler stickers are awarded in Friday assemblies.






Phonics Screening
